

### SELECTION CRITERIA

Weightage of 50% will be given to class 10th marks. Weightage of 50% will be given to diploma marks. 5 marks each will be given for higher qualification of graduate degree and post graduate degree. Percentage of marks in graduate degree will be counted only if the candidate has not done diploma. Academic qualifications acquired upto closing date i.e. 10.07.2017 would be considered only.

Examples given below are only for illustration purposes:

- 1- Candidate A has achieved 480 marks out of total 500 marks in class 10<sup>th</sup> and 460 marks out of total 500 marks in diploma. His merit score is  $48+46 = 94$
- 2- Candidate B has achieved 440 marks out of total 500 marks in class 10<sup>th</sup> and 380 marks out of total 500 marks in diploma and he has done bachelors degree also. His merit score is  $44+38 +5= 87$
- 3- Candidate C has achieved 380 marks out of total 500 marks in class 10<sup>th</sup> and 380 marks out of total 500 marks in diploma and he has done bachelors degree and masters degree also. His merit score is  $38+38 +5 + 5= 86$
- 4- Candidate D has achieved 360 marks out of total 500 marks in class 10<sup>th</sup> and 380 marks out of total 500 marks in degree and he has not done diploma. His merit score is  $36+38 +5= 79$
- 5- Candidate E has achieved 360 marks out of total 500 marks in class 10<sup>th</sup> and 440 marks out of total 500 marks in degree and he has not done diploma but has done masters. His merit score is  $36+44 +5+5 = 90$

Merit list in order for five candidates is as:
